Please join us in worship on **November 2**, for the baptism of StorieLane Whiteside.

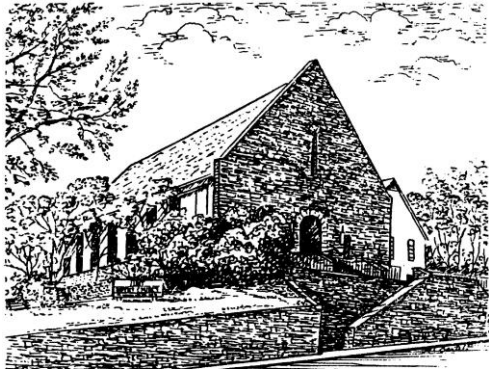
