Community Thanksgiving Service, **Sunday, November 23, 7:00pm**, at Tryon Presbyterian Church.

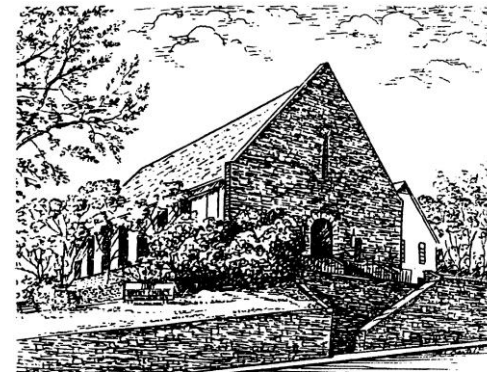
