Spirituality/Backpack Trip June 12-14

This year we'll be trekking in the Pisgah National Forest and Shining Rock Wilderness from June 12-14.

The purpose of the backpacking trip is to provide an opportunity for Sabbath in a natural environment, and to help participants explore opportunities for prayer and silence.
