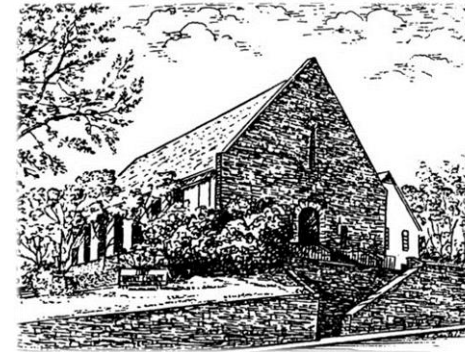
Looking Ahead....

if I invite and bring them.

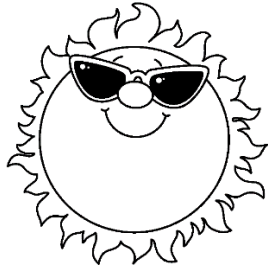
It will be a church where people grow in faith and serve you,
