

Hurricane Matthew Response - We'd love to have you join us as we seek to help Hurricane Matthew victims. We will leave Thursday evening, Nov 10, at 7pm to travel to Lumberton, NC. We will work all day Friday, and until noon on Saturday. We will "mud out" houses and other grunt labor. We will sleep on the floor at FBC Lumberton, so you will need to provide your own sleeping pad/cot, sleeping bag, pillow, etc. (Showers are available.)

S.E.E, November 13 – Children (grades 1-5) and preschooler activities begin at 5pm in the educational space of the main building, and youth (grades 6-12) meet in the lower level of the Activity Building. Adults in the Activity Building will study Barbara Brown Taylor's *"The Luminous Web."* If you're meeting at the Rock House, the study will be Adam Hamilton's *"Half-Truths – God Helps Those Who Help Themselves and Other Things the Bible Doesn't Say."*

Operation Christmas Child is a shoebox ministry, sponsored by Samaritan's Purse. Children and families are encouraged to fill a shoebox with appropriate toys, clothing, and treats. There are shoeboxes available in the narthex closet, or you can use your own container. Labels and instructions on how to pack your box are in the education hallway. Please be sure to note what items cannot be included, and also remember to put a check for \$7 in the box, made out to "Samaritan's Purse" **Deadline for shoebox collection is coming very soon—we need your filled shoeboxes by next Sunday, November 13.**
