

PUERTO RICO TRIP

As you begin thinking about summer plans, we hope you will consider joining us June 24th-July 1st on our mission trip to Carolina, Puerto Rico. There will be a variety of opportunities for service such as painting, vacation bible school, nursing home visits, and food distribution. We will also get several Puerto Rican cultural experiences which may include hiking through El Yunque (a national rainforest), having a Salsa dancing lesson, and adventuring through Old San Juan. We are in the process of checking flight fares and need a solid number by February 15th. The current total cost estimate per person is around \$700.00 which includes all meals, supplies, lodging, and flights; this cost will very possibly be less based on flight costs.
