Looking ahead.....we will also pack/deliver the weeks of July 22 and August 19.

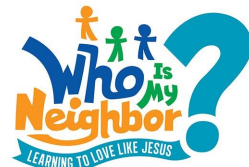

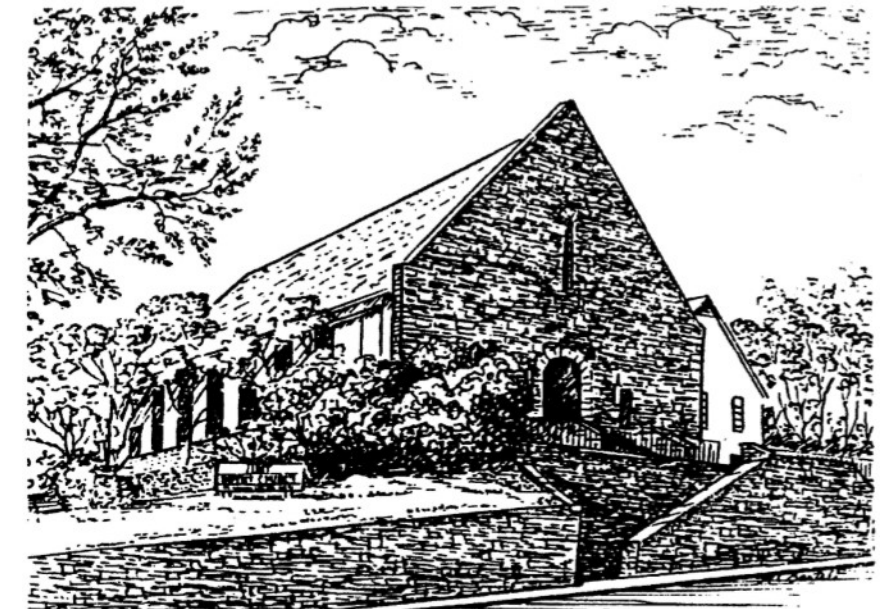
